SUBJECT: Radio Relay Corp.-California. Order Authorizing a 30-day notice period for cancellation of service, and a one-time connection charge of \$10.00 per customer. Expected annual revenue increase is \$24,000. Resolution No. T-10991.

WHEREAS: RADIO RELAY CCRP.-CALIFORNIA, by Advice Letter no. 29, filed October 22, 1985, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to take effective the following tariff revisions:

- Changing notice of cancellation of service by a customer from two days to 30 days.
- 2. Adding a onc-time connection charge of \$10.00 per new customer.
- 3. Charges for service will accrue after cancellation until any utility provided equipment is returned.

The utility has found that the present cancellation notice period of two days is insufficient for processing. Customers have continued to use the service and equipment after giving this short notice, avoiding payment for service during the period the cancellation is being processed.

The utility finds the institution of a one-time connection charge of \$10.00 for new accounts to be necessary to meet increased costs of administration. The expected annual revenue increase is \$24,000.

Notice was given to Radio Relay's customers concurrently with the advice letter filing. No complaints or concents have been made. Radio Relay provides radiotelephone service in the greater Los Angeles area.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on January 9, 1986.
- (2) Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 196-T and 197-T shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Cormission of the State of California No. T-10991.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
