SUBJECT: Citizens Utilities Company of California. Order authorizing deviation from the tariff pagination requirements of General Order No. 9C-A, and tariff format modification. Resolution No. T-10992.

WHEREAS: CITIZENS by Advice Letter No. 399 filed Cotober 9, 1985 requests authority under Section 701 of the Public Utilities Case to deviate from the requirements of General Order (GO) No. 96-A in the following respects:

1. To initiate a separate set of tariff schedules for one-way and two-way mobile radiotelephone service, these tariffs to be based on a separate series of advice letter filings;

- 2. To delcte the present offerings of mobile service in Elk Grove from the existing schedule A-22 and to provide Elk Grove Service under new tariff schedules as described, at the same or reduced rates; and
- To use the alternate method of schedule and sheet numbering for those new schedules, in the same manner as authorized to Pacific Bell and various other telephone corporations pursuant to Resolutions U-275, March 25, 1947, and T-4886, February 26, 1962.

Citizens has been granted certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide mobile service in several areas in California (Sacramento, San Diego and San Francisco) apart from its wireline service area. A condition of these grants is that Citizens maintain its records and accounts for these services separately from its wireline services, as one means of insuring avoidance of any possible anticompetitive cross-subsidy. In its implementation of this, Citizens proposes to maintain its tariff administration for these services in a separate basis.

The Cormission finds that the proposed deviations are in the public interest; and, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED the authority is granted to implement the above deviations effective on January 9, 1986.
