SUBJECT: Citizens Utilities Company of California. Order Authorizing a three minute limitation on mobile radiotelephone calls in the Elk Grove serving area. Resolution No. T-10995.

WHEREAS: CITIZENS, by Advice Letter No. 400, filed November 14, 1985, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code make effective the following tariff revisions:

To provide that the utility may limit the length of conversation of its two-way mobile radiotelephone system in the Elk Grove serving area to three minutes, or in times of emergency, to less than three minutes for the duration of the emergency.

There are nine customers to this service in the Elk Grove area. Customers have been notified of this change and no protests have been received.

There is only one two-way channel available in Elk Grove, and through experience the utility finds it necessary to be able to limit calls in order to assure equitable access to the channel.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:


(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on January 9, 1986.
