SUBJECT: Pacific Bell. Order authorizing an agreement to provide Farmer Line Service to Michael O'Keefe. Resolution No. T-10997.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC BELL, by letter filed October 23, 1985, pursuant to Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code, General Order No. 96-A and Resolution T-4886, requests authority to enter into an agreement with Michael O'Keefe.

Under the terms of the agreement Pacific Bell will provide Farmer Line Service to Michael O'Keefe and he will furnish, own and maintain service equipment in proper operating condition, including the interface, at point of contact with Pacific's facilities.

The area to be served is located outside of Pacific's Ukiah exchange. Pacific could serve the applicant and about five other nearby parcels under local exchange tariffs if the Ukiah exchange boundary was extended to include these areas. However, it would cost approximately \$96,500 to construct the facilities necessary to service the properties. The cost for the installation of Farmer Line Service is nominal.

Pacific believes it is in the best interest of all its ratepayers not to incorporate the area and instead proposes to offer Farmer Lines Service to the area in question from its existing facilities under a contractual agreement. The Ukiah exchange and service area tariff rates and charges would be applicable for this offering.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:


(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on January 9, 1986.

(2) The agreement authorized herein shall be marked to show that such agreement was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-10997.
