SUBJECT: Pacific Bell. Order authorizing deviation from filed tariff schedules to continue to provide Tracy local exchange service to one customer who has inadvertently been provided Tracy exchange since 1957 despite the fact the customer resides in the Liverrore exchange. Resolution No. T-11003.

MIEREAS: PACIFIC BELL, by Advice Letter No. 15036, filed December 30, 1985, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from the tariff schedules as follows:

To continue to provide Tracy local exchange service to one customer who has inadvertently been provided Tracy exchange since 1957 despite the fact the customer resides in the Livernore exchange.

The customer's service has not previously been authorized by deviation.

The customer is located 2000 feet inside the Livermore/Tracy exchange and utility officials have not been able to determine how or why the customer ever received Tracy exchange service. However, the customer wishes to retain his Tracy number as his community of interest is in Tracy.

The Livermore and Tracy common exchange boundary also serves as an interLATA contiguous exchange boundary. Pacific does not wish a boundary change. On January 30, 1985 Pacific obtained a waiver from the United States District County (Civil Action NO. 82-0192, US of A vs Western Electric Company, Inc., et al dated December 28, 1983) to continue to provide interLATA foreign exchange service to subscribers on record as of December 31, 1983. Since the customer's service has been in place since 1957, Pacific feels that the customer's situation is within the intent of the waiver. The utility recommends that the customer retain his Tracy numbers.

There are no costs associated with this proposal and annual revenues will not be affected.

Such deviation is hereby found to be justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority is granted to make the aforesaid deviation by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11003.

The effective date of this resolution is today.
