SUBJECT: Jeanette Lipton dba Valley Voice Paging. Order Authorizing increase in initial minimum contract period and requirement that utility be given 30 days' notice for termination of service. Resolution No. T-11005.

WHEREAS: JEANETTE LIPTON dba VALLEY VOICE PAGING, by Advice Letter No. 6, filed November 14, 1965, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

- 1. To increase the initial minimum contract period from one to three months.
- 2. To require that the utility be given 30 days' advance notice of termination of service.

  Customers have been notified of the proposed changes. No protests have been received by the Commission staff. The utility states that these revisions are necessary for orderly financial planning and minimization of customer churn.

Valley Voice Paging serves the greater Los Angeles area.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,
