SUBJECT: General Telephone Company of Calif. Order authorizing extension to July 31, 1986 of the experimental offering of cellular mobile radiotelephone service by resale.

Resolution No. T-11012.

WHEREAS: GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF CALIF, by Advice Letter No. 4990, filed January 30, 1986, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to rake effective the following tariff revisions:

To extend to July 31, 1986, the experimental offering of cellular mobile radiotelephone service by resale.

The utility's affiliate GTEL has applied for a certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to engage in cellular resale. It had been contemplated that GTEL would be certificated prior to the expiration of the General Telephone tariff on January 31, 1986. However, GTEL's application was not filed until January 21, 1986, and it is therefore necessary to extend the General Telephone tariff to avoid disruption in service.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS CRDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on March 6, 1986.

(2) Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets No. L-2, 2nd Revised Sheet 1 shall be marked to show that such sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11012.
