SUBJECT: Crico Telecommunications of San Jose (U-2051-C). Order authorizing a service restoration charge, a returned check charge, and the limitation of manual tone-only and tone-and-voice paging to existing customers. The expected revenue effect is minimal. Resolution No. T-11018.

WHEREAS: CRICO TELECOMMUNICATIONS OF SAN JOSE, by Advice Letter No. 32, filed February 24, 1986, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

- (1) To institute a charge of \$10 for restoration of service following suspension of service for non-payment or other authorized cause;
- (2) To institute a charge of \$10 for processing of a check returned for insufficient funds;
- (3) To limit the offerings of manual tone-only and manual tone-and-voice paging to existing customers; there are 14 manual tone-and-voice paging customers at this time and no manual tone-only customers. The utility will terminate its manual offering at such time as the remaining customers either cancel or convert to automatic dial paging service. The manual service is obsolescent and there is no new demand for it.

The charges for service restoration and for returned checks are intended to cover the associated administrative costs and also to service as deterrents. The revenue effects are expected to be minimal, less than \$100 annually.

Customer notice has been given as of the filing date and no protests have been received.

The utility by this filing also reduces certain rates for automatic dial paging to meet competition. The utility projects that the resulting stimulation will at least offset the rate reductions.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that:
