SUNECI: Coast Mobilphone Service. Order authorizing a late payment charge of 1 1/2 percent per month, and a charge of \$10.00 for each check not honored by a bank. The expected revenue effect is minimal. Resolution No. T-11021.

MikkEAS: Coast Mobilphone Service, by Advice Letter No. 16, filed March 6, 1986, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to take effective the following revisions:

- 1. To establish a late payment charge of 1 1/2 percent per month.
- 2. To authorize a charge of \$10.00 for each check not honored by a bank.

Each of these charges agrees with current industry practices.

Customers were advised of these proposed changes during December, 1985, and no protests have been received.

The expected increase in revenue is less than \$100 per annum. The charges authorized are primarily intended as deterrents. The utility is also by this filing eliminating an excess message charge for tone-and-voice paging, which has been found to be unnecessary in practice.

The Cormission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and that present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

## II IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on April 6, 1980.

(2) Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 89-T shall be marked to show that such sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11021.
