WHEREAS: WESTCOM-DATATEL, INC. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a reseller of telecommunications services within the State of California on May 2, 1984 by Decision 84-05-008 in Application 84-04-046; and

MHEREAS: Westcom-Datatel, Inc. has failed to respond to various correspondence by mail, including an Annual Fee Statement for P.U.C. Utilities Reimbursement Account, which was returned "Moved Left No Address", and has had its telephone number disconnected with no new number; and

MHEREAS: Pacific Bell has informed the Commission that Westcom-Datatel, Inc. was disconnected for non-payment of delinquent bills over one year ago and has left no forwarding address or telephone number. Therefore, staff has requested that the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for Westcom-Datatel, Inc. be revoked.

The Commission finds that the authority granted by D.84-05-008 for Kestcom-Datatel, Inc. should be revoked pursuant to the information above; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) The operating authority granted of Westcom-Datatel, Inc. by D.84-05-008 is revoked.

(2) Westcom-Datatel, Inc. is no longer subject to the user fee as a percentage of gross intrastate revenue pursuant to Public Utilities Code Sections 431-435.

(3) A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the formal file of A.84-04-046.
