SUBJECT: Tadlock's Communications, Inc. (U-2059-C). Order authorizing the institution of a late payment charge. Resolution No. T-11059.

WHEREAS: TADLOCK'S COMMUNICATIONS, INC., by Advice Letter No. 18 filed, July 1, 1986, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

To institute a late payment charge of one percent for payments received more than twenty days after the due date. The date of sending, the due date, and the late payment charge will be indicated on the bill.

The utility has not previously had such a charge. The new provision is substantially the same as that authorized for the independent wireline telephone companies by D.86-04-046, except that Tadlock elects a charge of one percent per month instead of 1.5%. The effect of the charge is primarily as a deterrent to late payment and no appreciable revenue effect is expected. Notice of the charge will be included in all customer billings. No charge will be applied until thirty days following notice to customers.

The filing also includes new forms and a new offering, which do not require Commission approval pursuant to PU Code Sec. 455.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on August 7, 1986.

(2) Schedule Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 147-T shall be marked to show that such sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11059.
