> SUBJECT: Continental Telephone Company of California. Order authorizing establishing a charge for providing Traffic Usage Studies Service, which was previously offered free of charge. The estimated annual revenue is approximately \$48,300. Resolution No. T-11060.

MHEREAS: CONTINENTAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by Advice Letter No. 755 filed, July 14, 1986, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

To establish a tariff charge for Traffic Usage Studies Service which was previously offered free of charge to customers upon request. The service charges are for 7, 14 and 21 day studies for customer's connected to either an analog or digital central office. The charges are as follows:

Study Period	Analog Switch	Digital Switch
7 days	\$1,350.00	\$ 640.00
14 days	1,680.00	970.00
21 days	2,010.00	i,300.00

Some customers who are considering purchasing new equipment may request the utility to provide traffic studies on the customer's existing trunk lines. The study includes information on the number of calls on the access lines and the number of calls that reach a busy condition during a specified period of time. The customer uses this data to determine how many trunk lines are needed and the size and type of telephone system to buy.

Continental forecasts that between 50-75 customers per year, may request this service, justifying a general offering. Estimated annual revenue is approximately \$48,300.

Notice will be provided individually to customers inquiring about the service.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on August 14, 1986.

(2) Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A-12, Fourth Revised Sheet 2-T shall be marked to show that such sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11060.
