SUBJECT: General Telephone Company of California. (U-1002-C) Order authorizing the withdrawal of the offering of Cellular Radio Telecommunications Service, for which there are no Customers. Resolution No. T-11067.

WHEREAS: GENERAL TELEPHONE COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 5033 filed, March 13, 1986, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

To withdraw Cellular Radio Telecommunications Service as provided in Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. L-2.

This service is now offered to existing and future subscribers by a subsidiary, GTEL, as approved by Commission Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity, dated April 17, 1986 in Decision 86-04-052. GTEL has noticed subscribers of the transfer of service, and GTEL has filed tariffs by Advice Letter No. 1, effective June 9, 1986. Therefore, there is no existing or future requirement by General Telephone Company to provide this service from its Schedule No. L-2.

There are presently no customers for this service and no applications for such services on file; and good cause appearing,

Authority is hereby granted pursuant to Resolution No. T-9597 to make the above revisions effective September 7, 1986, and Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. L-2 shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11067.
