> SUBJECT: Los Angeles SMSA Limited Partnership, Sacramento-Valley Limited Partnership, and PacTel Mobile Access. Order Authorizing tariff revisions on less than statutory notice, providing equal access to toll carriers for subscribers to cellular mobile radiotelephone service. Resolution No. T-11068.

WHEREAS: LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, by Advice Letter No. 17, SACRAMENTO-VALLEY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, by Advice Letter No. 8, and PACTEL MOBILE ACCESS, by Advice Letter No. 13, all filed August 15, 1986, request authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice the following tariff revisions:

To provide for equal access to interLATA toll carriers for subscribers to cellular mobile radiotelephone service in the Los Angeles, Sacramento, and San Diego areas, respectively.

Authorization on less than statutory notice is requested to permit the carriers to comply with the requirements of the Modified Final Judgement in the matter of The United States of America vs. Eastern Electric Company, Civil Action No. 82-0192. As an affiliate of a Bell Operating Company, each of the above cellular carriers is obliged to make equal toll access available by September 1, 1986. Earlier filing of these revisions was not possible because of unavoidable delays in software modifications and the procurement of hardware as needed for the new capability.

As a new offering, this filing does not require authorization, pursuant to Section 455 of the Public Utilities Code, but only our authorization to become effective on less than 30 days' notice as provided by Section 491. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on September 5, 1986.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the associated tariff sheets be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11068. This resolution is effective today.
