WHEREAS: AALERT PAGING COMPANY OF SACRAMENTO, by Advice Letter
No. 2-Radiotelephone, filed November 10, 1986, requests authority under
Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the
following tariff revisions:

To impose a charge of \$10 for each check which is returned
unpaid for any reason. The charge applies on a per-check basis
regardless of the number of accounts to which the payment would be
applied.

Notification is being given to each customer on his next billing
beginning November 6, 1986. The charge will not be applied until
customer notification has been completed. No protests to the
charge have been received as of today.

No appreciable revenue effect is foreseen as a returned check charge
functions primarily as a deterrent.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions
authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present
rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges
and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future
unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions
effective on December 11, 1986.

(2) Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 29-T shall be marked to show that such sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11086.
