AAlert Paging Company of San Diego (U-2086-C) and AAlert Paging Company of San Francisco (U-2085-C). Order authorizing the establishment of a returned check charge of \$10. No appreciable revenue effect is expected. Resolution No. T-11087.

WHEREAS: AALERT PAGING COMPANY OF SAN DIEGO and AALERT PAGING COMPANY OF SAN FRANCISCO, by Advice Letters No. 2-Radio-telephone, filed November 12, 1986, request authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

To impose a charge of \$10 for each check which is returned unpaid for any reason. The charge applies on a per-check basis regardless of the number of accounts to which the payment would be applied.

Notification is being given to each customer on his next billing beginning November 6, 1986. The charge will not be applied until customer notification has been completed. No protests to the charge have been received as of today.

No appreciable revenue effect is foreseen as a returned check charge functions primarily as a deterrent.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on December 13, 1986.

(2) Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 29-T for each company shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11087.
