SUBJECT: Roseville Telephone Company (U-1015-C). Order authorizing increased rates for tone-and-voice radio paging. No revenue effect is predicted at this time. Resolution No. T-11092.

WHEREAS: ROSEVILLE TELEPHONE COMPANY, by Advice Letter No. 241 filed December 4, 1986, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

To increase the rates for tone-and-voice radio paging as follows:

Number of pagers on an account	Present Monthly Rate	Proposed Monthly Rate
1 to 3, ea.	\$11.00	\$12.00
4 to 6, ea.	10.00	11.50
7 to 9, ea.	9.00	11.00
10 or more	8.00	10.50

Message allowance remains unchanged at 75 per month, \$0.20 for each excess message.

By this advice letter Roseville also is reducing rates for tone-only and for digital display paging, pursuant to Sec. 455 of the Public Utilities Code.

The utility wishes to stimulate use of tone-only and display paging, which are more efficient in terms of channel capacity utilization, and to limit the use of tone-and-voice, which is much less efficient.

Notice is not required as there are no customers as this time for tone-and-voice service. This also results in no revenue effect at this time from this rate increase.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges

and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on January 18, 1987.

(2) Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1831-T and 1833-T shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11092.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
