SUBJECT: Continental Telephone Company of California.
Authority to withdraw utility-provided Music Access
System Service in the Blythe exchange. There are no
customers for this service. Resolution No. T-11094.

WHEREAS: CONTINENTAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by Advice
Letter No. 771 filed December 26, 1986, requests authority under
Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the
following tariff revisions:

Continental Telephone Company of California (Contel) proposes to
withdraw utility-provided Music Access System Service. This
utility-provided service offers music on hold for key and PBX
services offered by the Utility.

This service is currently offered only in the Blythe exchange as
the result of an existing service offered by a former telephone
company purchased by Contel. There is no demand for this service
as customer provided equipment offers the same service at
competitive or cheaper rates. The utility has no plans to offer
this service on an exchange wide basis.

There are no customers for this service and no future customers
are anticipated. No handicapped services are involved with this
withdrawal of service.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions
authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present
rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges
and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future
unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on January 28, 1987.

(2) Schedule No. G-4, Third Revised Cal. P.U.C. Sheet No. 2-T shall be marked to show that such sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-11094.
