SUBJECT: Pacific Bell (U-1001-C). Order authorizing the withdrawal of the offering of 35 Megahertz two-way radiotelephone service in Bakersfield, Fresno, Lebec and Sacramento, for which there are no customers. Resolution No. T-12002.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC BELL, by Advice Letter No. 15212, filed January 13, 1987, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

To withdraw the offering of two-way mobile radiotelephone service in the 35 MHz band in Bakersfield, Fresno, Lebec and Sacramento.

The Federal Communications Commission has ordered the discontinuance of the 35 MHz channels for two-way public mobile radiotelephone service no later than June 30, 1988. See 47 CFR 22.501(a), Note. Consequently, Pacific has frozen all 35 MHz two-way service and at such time as a particular exchange area no longer has 35 MHz customers, the offering is withdrawn for that area.

There are presently no customers for this service and no applications for such services on file; and good cause appearing,

Authority is hereby granted pursuant to Resolution No. T-9597 to make the above revisions effective on February 13, 1987, and Schedule Cal. P.U.C. No. A7, 4th Revised Sheets 533, 535, 546, 548 and 557 shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-12002.
