SUBJECT: Los Angeles SMSA Limited Partnership (U-3063-C).
Order authorizing an extension for 120 days of a
provisional program of cooperative advertising for
resellers of Partnership's cellular mobile
radiotelephone service.

WHEREAS: LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, by Advice
Letter No. 24, filed January 30, 1987, requests authority under
Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the
following tariff revisions:

To extend for a period of 120 days the provisional program
of cooperative advertising which was initially authorized by
Resolution T-11085, December 3, 1986.

The program content and its terms and conditions remain
unchanged from the original authorization. The utility
wishes to extend the provisional offering to obtain a higher
confidence in the long term viability of the program concept.

The program provides for partial reimbursement to those
resellers of cellular service which expend funds on advertising and
promotion of Partnership's service, as more fully set forth in
Resolution T-11085.

The Commission finds that the extension of the provisional
offering should be authorized as described; and, good cause
appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions
effective on March 11, 1987.

(2) Schedule Cal. PUC No. 3-T, 1st Revised Sheet 13, shall be marked to show that such sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-12006.
