R E S O L U T I O N

LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY (U-3009-C). ORDER
AUTHORIZING AN INCREASED USAGE RATE FOR ROAMER SERVICE IN THE
LOS ANGELES AREA. RESOLUTION T-12016.

WHEREAS: Los Angeles Cellular Telephone Company, by Advice Letter No. 3, filed March 13, 1987, requests authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective the following tariff revisions:

To increase the per minute rate charged to "roamer" users on the utility's system from \$0.50 per minute to \$0.70 per minute.

"Roamers" are cellular radiotelephone users whose home system is not this utility, but have arranged for access to this system while they are in this utility's serving area.

By this filing the utility also deleted a daily access charge for roamers, which has been tariffed at \$5.00 per day, \$15 minimum and \$75 maximum.

As of the filing date of Advice Letter No. 3, the Los Angeles Cellular Telephone Company system is not yet operational. Consequently, there have been no "roamers" and no revenue received for roaming service ; accordingly, there is no revenue effect associated with this filing.

The Commission finds that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable and present rates, charges and conditions, as they differ from the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are for the future unjust and unreasonable; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above revisions effective on April 23, 1987.

(2) Revised Cal PUC Sheet No. 91-T shall be marked to show that sheet was authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-12016.

(3) This Resolution is effective today.
