RESQLUTION

(EXECUTIVE ACTION RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PACIFIC BELL TO CONTINUE TO PROVIDE CONCORD EXCHANGE SERVICE TO 5 CUSTOMERS LOCATED IN A TERRITORY BEING TRANSFERRED TO THE PITTSBURG EXCHANGE; CONTINUE TO PROVIDE PITTSBURG EXCHANGE SERVICE TO 29 CUSTOMERS LOCATED IN A TERRITORY BEING TRANSFERRED TO THE CONCORD EXCHANGE.)

SUMMARY

This resolution authorizes Pacific Bell to transfer .15 of a square le from the Concord Exchange to the Pittsburg Exchange and 1.46 quare miles from the Pittsburg Exchange to the Concord Exchange to effectively and economically service the territories.

As a result of this boundary realignment, Pacific Bell is requesting authority to deviate from its filed tariffs and continue to provide Concord Exchange service to 5 customers located in a territory to be transferred to the Pittsburg Exchange and Pittsburg Exchange service to 29 customers situated in a territory to be transferred to the Concord Exchange. All 34 customers have expressed their community of interest and their intentions to remain in the exchanges they are under prior to the boundary realignment.

BACKGROUND

The .15 of a square mile of territory being transferred from the Concord Exchange to the Pittsburg Exchange bisects the Moto Ranch subdivision which has 140 single family homes and the California Landing subdivision which has 128 condominium units. This area can be more economically served from the Pittsburg Exchange because it is within 5,000 feet of the Pittsburg wire center, which also serves adjacent subdivisions in the Pittsburg Exchange. Cost savings to Pacific Bell is estimated at \$46,500 to provide service from the Pittsburg Exchange as opposed to the Concord Exchange.

Out of the affected 268 subscribers in this territory, there are 5 customers requesting to be retained under the Concord Exchange Service. The Concord Exchange service rate is \$8.25 for 1 Flat Residence, \$4.45 1 Measured Residence and \$8.25 for 1 Measured Business. The local calling areas are Concord, Lafayette, Martinez, Pittaburg-Gladstone and Walnut Creek.

The 1.46 square miles of territory being transferred from the Pittsburg Exchange to the Concord Exchange encompasses the Clyde community which petitioned the Public Utilities Commission on August 3, 1987 to obtain Concord area local service. The Clyde area is composed of about 165 customers. There are also 34 Concord foreign exchange customers who will convert to Concord local service upon transfer of the area. From an economic standpoint, the transfer area can best be served thru the Concord Exchange.

There is also a proposed subdivision of 64 new homes in the Clyde area for development in 1988. It can be economically served thru the Concord Exchange because of the presence of cable and facilities as opposed to new construction which is estimated at \$101,400 if connection is done via the Pittsburg Exchange.

There are 29 subscribers located in the area for transfer requesting to be retained under the Pittsburg Exchange. The Pittsburg Exchange service rate is \$8.25 for 1 Flat Residence, \$4.60 for 2 Flat Residence, \$17.15 for 1 Flat Business and \$11.70 for 2 Flat Business. The local calling areas are Pittsburg, Antioch and Concord.

The estimated annual revenue effect associated with this advice letter filing is a decrease of \$5,097 broken down as follows:

- 1. Mileage charges eliminated due to the expansion of the Concord Base Rate Area (BRA) \$1,474.20.
- 2. Conversion of Foreign Exchange service to Concord local (30 1 Party Residence and 4 1 Party Business) \$3,622.80.

DISCUSSION

Since the 5 subscribers in the Concord Exchange and the 29 subscribers in the Pittsburg Exchange have expressed and indicated their intentions to retain their Concord local service and their Pittsburg local service, respectively, it will be inappropriate to require them to subscribe to the exchange of territories due to Pacific Bell's initiated boundary realignment and a petition for change from a majority of subscribers. This said, it would be reasonable to authorize Pacific Bell to deviate from its filed tariffs and allow these 34 customers to continue with their existing service even if this will constitute a deviation from the filed tariffs.

In Resolution T-9599, the Commission has authorized the Executive Director to grant a utility's request to deviate from filed tariffs for customers whose exchange services are affected by a utility initiated boundary change or serving central office rearrangement.

THEREFORE:

- (1) Effective March 28, 1988, Pacific Bell is authorized to continue providing Concord Exchange service to the 5 subscribers appearing in Exhibit 1 regardless of its filed tariffs for a transfer of territory from the Concord Exchange to the Pittsburg Exchange.
- (2) Effective March 28, 1988, Pacific Bell is authorized to continue providing Pittsburg Exchange service to 29 subscribers appearing in Exhibit 2 regardless of its filed tariffs for a transfer of territory from the Pittsburg Exchange to the Concord Exchange.
- (3) All tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 15347 shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-12072.
- (4) The effective date of this Resolution is today.
