R E S O L U T I O NAT&T EXECUTIVE AUTHORITY TO WITHDRAW 50 KILOBIT SWITCHED SERVICE, FOR WHICH THERE ARE NO CUSTOMERSSUMMARY

By Advice Letter No. 99, filed June 17, 1988, AT&T seeks authority to withdraw 50 Kilobit Switched Service, because there are no customers and no applications on file for service. Authority is granted to withdraw this service.

BACKGROUND

AT&T seeks authority to withdraw this service because there are no customers. AT&T has been providing this service since divestiture. Since 1980 they have not had any customers for this service and there are no requests for service on file.

DISCUSSION

Since there are no customers currently receiving 50 Kilobit Switched Service and no requests for service are on file, we therefore allow AT&T to withdraw this offering.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) Authority is granted to make the above deletion effective today.
- (2) Revised sheets within Schedule CA1. P.U.C. No. B3 Channels shall be marked to show such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission for the State of California Resolution No. T-13001.
