September 14, 1988R E S O L U T I O NPACIFIC BELL. ORDER AUTHORIZING IMPLEMENTATION OF NEW
INSTALLATION RATES FOR SECRETARIAL LINES BASED ON WIRE
CENTER DISTINCTION.SUMMARY

This resolution authorizes Pacific Bell to implement new installation rates of \$125 and \$277 on less than regular notice for secretarial lines based on wire center distinction of Single Wire Center and a Multiple Wire Center, respectively, to become effective September 15, 1988.

BACKGROUND

Ordering Paragraph No. 53a, of Decision No. 88-07-022, dated July 8, 1988 states:

"53a. Pacific shall make an advice letter filing with this Commission pursuant to GO 96-A to establish separate tariff language for designed and nondesigned secretarial lines. This distinction shall be based on the multi versus single central office distinction developed by TASC on the record. Upon adoption by this Commission by resolution of Pacific's tariff language, the new installation rates of \$125 for nondesigned line and \$277 for designed line shall be authorized."

On August 8, 1988, Pacific filed Advice Letter No. 15437 requesting authority to implement the new installation rates for secretarial lines based on multi versus single wire center distinction in accordance with the above mentioned ordering paragraph. Pacific requests that the new installation rates become effective September 15, 1988.

Decision No. 88-07-022 provided for the installation of secretarial lines be based on multi versus single wire center distinction subject to Commission approval. The new installation rates of \$125 for nondesigned line and \$277 for designed lines and their associated revenues have already been reflected in the rate restructure authorized in that decision. Therefore, Pacific's request to implement the new installation rates on less than regular notice is appropriate. No customer protests have been received.

FINDINGS

We find that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this Resolution are just and reasonable; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

(1) Authority is granted to make the above tariff revisions contained in Advice Letter No. 15437 effective September 15, 1988.

(2) All tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 15437 shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-13014.
