RESOLUTION NO. T-13031 November 9, 1988

RESOLUTION

CP NATIONAL. ORDER AUTHORIZING A DEVIATION FROM FILED TARIFF SCHEDULES TO WAIVE THE APPLICATION SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGES FOR CUSTOM CALLING AND TOUCH CALLING SERVICE.

SUMMARY

CP National by Advice Letter No. 245-T filed October 20, 1988, has requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code, to make effective the following tariff deviations:

- (1) For the period from November 9, 1988 to January 9, 1989, to waive the Service Connection Charge for Touch Calling Service in all CP National exchanges.
- (2) For the period from November 9, 1988 to January 9, 1989, to waive the Service Connection Charge for Custom Calling Service in the Colusa and Needles Exchanges.

Although there will be a loss of revenue due to the waived service connection charges, the projected effect of this promotional offering is an estimated net revenue gain of \$670.

BACKGROUND

Touch Calling and Custom Calling Services are discretionary services priced to provide a significant revenue contribution towards the support of basic telephone services. Promotional offerings typically provide some temporary revenue loss, however this revenue will be recovered from the customers who keep the service.

PINDINGS

We find that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this resolution are just and reasonable.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) CP National is granted authority to deviate from filed tariffs schedules to waive the applicable Service Connection charges for Custom Calling Service and Touch Calling Service effective on November 9, 1988.
- (2) All tariff sheets filed under CP National's Advice Letter No. 245-T shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California Number T-13031.
- (3) The effective date of this Resolution is today.
