R E S O L U T I O N

SIERRA TELEPHONE COMPANY. ORDER AUTHORIZING A DEVIATION FROM FILED TARIFF SCHEDULES TO WAIVE THE SERVICE CONNECTION CHARGES FOR CUSTOM CALLING AND REMOTE CALL FORWARDING SERVICES ON LESS THAN REGULAR NOTICE.

SUMMARY

This resolution authorizes Sierra Telephone Company to waive the Service Connection charges associated with Custom Calling and Remote Call Forwarding Services for a one month promotional period starting December 1, 1988 and ending December 31, 1988. The projected effect of this promotional offering is a net revenue gain of \$9,375 over a one year period.

BACKGROUND

Sierra Telephone Company, by Advice Letter No. 135, filed November 3, 1988, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from filed tariff to waive the Service Connection Charge for Custom Calling Service and Remote Call Forwarding Service for the period from December 1, 1988 to December 31, 1988.

Custom Calling and Remote Call Forwarding Services are discretionary services priced to provide a significant revenue contribution towards the support of basic telephone services. Promotional offerings typically result in some temporary revenue losses. However, this lost revenue will be recovered from the stimulated demand for the service. Sierra estimates the net revenue gain from this promotional offering to be \$9,375 after one year.

FINDINGS

We find that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this resolution are just and reasonable; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) Sierra Telephone Company is granted authority to deviate from filed tariff schedules to waive the applicable Service Connection charges for Custom Calling Service and Remote Call Forwarding Service effective December 1, 1988.

- (2) All tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter No. 135 shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-13033.
- (3) The effective date of this resolution is today.
