January 27, 1989R E S O L U T I O NPACIFIC BELL. ORDER AUTHORIZING A MARKET TRIAL FOR SIX
BASIC SERVICE ELEMENTS UNDER A TWO-YEAR PROVISIONAL TARIFF.SUMMARY

This resolution adopts Pacific Bell's proposed tariff to offer six Basic Service Elements (BSEs) through a market trial. This two-year provisional tariff will become effective on January 30, 1989.

BACKGROUND

Ordering Paragraph Nos. 1 and 2 of Decision No. 88-11-026, dated November 9, 1988 states:

"1. Pacific Bell (Pacific) is granted ex parte authority to proceed with a Market Trial for six Basic Service Elements (BSEs) under a two-year provisional tariff, conditioned on the following:..."

"2. When all of the conditions provided by Ordering Paragraph 1 have been met, Pacific shall file a compliance tariff filing with service on all protestants. That compliance filing shall be effective upon resolution by the Commission."

In accordance with the aforementioned ordering paragraphs, Pacific filed Advice Letter No. 15492 on December 9, 1988 requesting authority to implement the new BSE tariff. Pacific filed Supplemental Advice Letter No. 15492A on December 14, 1988 to correct typographical errors.

Decision No. 88-11-026 granted Pacific ex parte authority to conduct a market trial for six BSEs conditioned on the requirements set forth in the aforementioned ordering paragraphs. In Advice Letter No. 15492, Pacific has made the appropriate tariff revisions outlined in Ordering Paragraph No. 1.

On November 16, 1988, Pacific filed its tracking plan with CACD in compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1e. A letter of endorsement from CACD was sent to Pacific on December 8, 1988 approving the tracking plan.

On November 21, 1988, Pacific filed its proposal for safeguarding market intelligence with CACD in accordance with Ordering Paragraph No. 1d. According to Pacific, all interested parties were also served with this proposal. Pacific has met all the conditions stated in Ordering Paragraph No. 1. No customer protests have been received.

FINDINGS

We find that the rates, charges and conditions authorized in this resolution are just and reasonable; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) Authority is granted to make the above tariff revisions contained in Advice Letter Nos. 15492 and 15492A effective January 30, 1989.
- (2) All tariff sheets filed under Advice Letter Nos. 15492 and 15492A shall be marked to show that such sheets were authorized by Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. T-13043.
- (3) The effective date of this resolution is today.
