RESOLUTION T-14066. ORDER CORRECTING CORPORATE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER OF AMERICAN CELLULAR COMMUNICATION, INC., FORMERLY CALIFORNIA BELL COMMUNICATIONS CORPORATION, U-2108-C.

---

**SUMMARY**

American Cellular Communications, Inc., (American) of 17060 Ventura Boulevard, Encino, CA 91316, is assigned the Corporate Identification number of U-4089-C. American, formerly California Bell Communications Corporation (CBCC), had been assigned corporate identification number U-2108-C, signifying a radiotelephone utility (RTU). American, however, is certificated as a reseller of cellular radiotelecommunications services, and should be assigned a different corporate identification number, one reserved for cellular telecommunications service resellers.

**BACKGROUND**

By Application A.89-01-036, CBCC applied for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) to operate as a reseller of cellular radio telecommunications services within California.

Decision D.89-04-026, April 12, 1989, granted CBCC a CPCN as a cellular reseller. CBCC was issued corporate identification number U-2108-C in ordering paragraph 6 of D.89-01-036. U-2108-C is a corporate identification number reserved for radiotelephone utilities (RTUs) offering 1-way radio paging and conventional mobile telephone services.

CBCC, now named American Cellular Communications, Inc., should be issued a corporate identification number reserved for resellers of cellular radiotelecommunications services within California, i.e., U-4089-C.

**DISCUSSION**

By error, CBCC was assigned a corporate identification number reserved for RTUs; CBCC, now American, should be reassigned a

new corporate identification number, U-4089-C, one reserved for resellers of cellular radiotelecommunications services.

The corporate identification number assigned to CBCC, U-2108-C, should be cancelled, and not reissued.

#### FINDINGS


1. CBCC was issued a CPCN as a cellular radiotelecommunications service reseller by Decision 89-04-026.
2. CBCC was assigned a corporated identification number U-2108-C. This is a corporate identification number reserved for RTUs.
3. CBCC, now named American, should be issued a corporate identification number U-4089-C; the number U-2108-C should be cancelled, and not reassigned.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The corporate identification number assigned to California Bell Communications Corporation, U-2108-C, should be cancelled and not reassigned.
2. A corporate identification number of U-4089-C should be assigned to American Cellular Communications, Inc., 17060 Ventura Boulevard, Encino, CA 91316.
3. The Director of the Commission Advisory and Compliance Division will send a copy of this Resolution to American Cellular Communications, Inc., and to the Director of the Management Services Division.
