RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION T-14160. ORDER REVOKING THE CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY GRANTED TO THE FOLLOWING COMPANIES: COMEX (ATHENA WANG), CENTRAL COAST, GRACE COMMUNICATIONS (TELCOR), TELAMARKETING COMMUNICATIONS OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA, ADVANCED CELLULAR PHONE COMPANY, CENTURY CITY CELLULAR, PROCOMM RETRIEVAL, INC., U.S. COMMUNICATIONS, INC., ATH COM, INC., CELLULINK, MODESTO CELLTELCO, ADVANCED COMMUNICATIONS SOFTWARE INC., UNITED TELENETWORKS, INC., HAL-RAD COMMUNICATIONS, INC., MEGAWATS, PAMTEL LONG DISTANCE MANAGEMENT COMPANY, AMPTELCO, INC., FIBERNET COMMUNICATIONS, COM-VEST LONG LINES SAN JOSE, COM-VEST LONG LINES FRESNO, TEL TEC EXCHANGE OF SOUTH BAY, COM-VEST TELECOMMUNICATIONS, CREATIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC., TELCOM COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

SUMMARY

This resolution revokes the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) of 24 long distance, cellular and radiotelephone companies who are no longer in business.

BACKGROUND

Companies that have gone out of business frequently fail to inform the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) of this fact. As a result, CPUC records of long distance, cellular and radiotelephone companies are often out of date. Currently, 30% of CPUC mailings to these companies are returned at state expense due to companies having gone out of business without such notification. These records are also used by several branches of the CPUC, the Franchise Tax Board and the Board of Equalization, as well as by other utilities, applicants and interested parties who are required to serve copies of applications, advice letters and other filings.

Resolution T-13057 signed by this Commission on May 10, 1989, removed ten out-of-business long distance companies from CPUC records which met the following criteria:

- 1. Access service disconnected.
- 2. Local telephone service disconnected.
- 3. Mail returned to the CPUC with no forwarding address.
- 4. Pailed to file required fees and reports.

In compliance with the criteria established in Resolution T13057, recent attempts have been made to contact numerous
companies by telephone and mail. When these attempts failed, the
Commission Advisory and Compliance Division (CACD) contacted
access telephone service providers (Local Exchange Companies) to
determine if telephone service was disconnected. Currently the
CACD has on file letters from Pacific Bell, GTE California and
Contel stating that the following companies do not have
telephone service:

Section 2107 and 2108 of the Public Utilities (P.U.) Code requires regulated companies to file annual financial reports. These companies have had mail returned to the CPUC for a "Second and Final Notice of Delinquent Annual Report." None of these companies have filed reports nor responded to staff contacts in 1990 for fees required by P.U. Code Sections 431-435 (P.U.C. Reimbursement Account) and Section 879 (Universal Lifeline Telephone Service); most have not filed fee reports since 1988.

DISCUSSION

Resolution T-13057 effective May 10, 1989, previously established criteria for removal of out-of-business companies. This resolution has used the same criteria to determine that the foregoing companies are out of business. It is reasonable to conclude that the companies listed above are no longer doing business in California and should have their CPCNs revoked.

PINDINGS

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- 1. The listed companies were previously granted authority to operate in California.
- 2. The listed companies have been reviewed pursuant to the criteria established in Resolution No. T-13057.
- 3. The listed companies no longer have telephone service, and there is no evidence that they are in business.
- 4. The listed companies' Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity should be revoked.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to these companies are revoked:
