

Resolution T-14207
Effective October 20, 1990

The proposed construction will be located at 11255 South Normandie Avenue, Los Angeles, California and is known as the Los Angeles Cellular Site No. 190. It will consist of a 360 foot, one-storey equipment shelter with an associated 50 foot antenna structure

The Los Angeles Cellular Site No. 190 will become part of LACTC's cellular system serving the Los Angeles Cellular Geographic Service Area.

Public notice that LACTC filed Advice Letter No. 65 requesting authority to construct the Los Angeles Cellular Site No. 190 appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's September 24, 1990 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LACTC's Advice Letter No. 65 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on LACTC's Advice Letter No. 65.

FINDINGS

1. On September 20, 1990, LACTC filed Advice Letter No. 65 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Los Angeles Cellular Site No. 190 cell located at 11255 South Normandie Avenue, Los Angeles, California.
2. The Los Angeles Cellular Site No. 190 represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in 84-06-110, granting LACTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 65 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.



5. A LACTC officer signed a declaration which states that LACTC has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 65.
6. Advice Letter No. 65 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Los Angeles Cellular Site No. 190: the County of Los Angeles, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY's request for authority to construct the Los Angeles Cellular Site No. 190 is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is October 20, 1990.
