RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION T-14208. LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF FOUR NEW CELL SITES IN THE LASLP's cellular geographic service area.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 82, FILED ON OCTOBER 17, 1990.

SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (LASLP), by Advice Letter No. 82, filed on October 17, 1990, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add four new cellular radiotelephone cell sites to its existing cellular system serving LASLP's cellular geographic service area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the new cell sites, known as the Orange Park Acres, Centennial High, Newport Center, and Rosebowl sites, located respectively in the cities of Orange, Corona, Newport, and Pasadena. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 82 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

LASLP has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission):

for the Orange Park Acres site, the City of Orange; for the Centennial High site, the State of California, Office of the State Architect; for the Newport Center site, the City of Newport; and for the Rosebowl site, the City of Pasadena. The FAA and FCC have jurisdiction over each site, but required no further permit for their construction.

The proposed construction for the Orange Park Acres site will be located at 7446 E. Chapman Avenue F. Orange, California. It will consist of a 600 square foot cellular communications facility on the second floor of an existing building and face mount antennas attached to the parapet of the building.

The proposed construction for the Centennial High site will be located at Centennial High School, Corona, California. It will consist of a 10-ft 6-inch x 30-ft freestanding wood frame utility structure to house electrical radio and power equipment. A 7-ft 6-inch tripod with cellular antennas will be mounted on the roof of the building.

The proposed construction for the Newport Center site will be located at 500 Newport Drive, Newport, California. It will consist of a 600 square foot facility to house electrical radio and power equipment on the penthouse level of an existing building. Cellular antennae will be attached to the roof of the building.

The proposed construction for the Rosebowl site will be located at 1222 North Fair Oaks Avenue, Pasadena, California. It will consist of a 1330 square foot cellular communications facility in an existing one story building and the placement of two microwave dishes and a cellular antenna on an existing 60 foot monopole owned by Los Angekes Cellular Telephone Company.

The Orange Park Acres, Centennial High, Newport Center, and Rosebowl sites will become part of LASLP's cellular system serving LASLP's cellular geographic service area.

Public notice that LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 82 requesting authority to construct the Orange Park Acres, Centennial High, Newport Center, and Rosebowl sites appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's CALDATE Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LASLP's Advice Letter No. 82 were nailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on LASLP's Advice Letter No. 82.

FINDINGS

- 1. On October 17, 1990, LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 82 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Orange Park Acres, Centennial High, Newport Center, and Rosebowl cell sites located respectively in the cities of Orange, Corona, Newport, and Pasadena.
- 2. The Orange Park Acres, Centennial High, Newport Center, and Rosebowl sites are additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in D.83-06-080, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 4. Advice Letter No. 82 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
- 5. A LASLP officer signed a declaration which states that LASLP has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 82.
- Advice Letter No. 82 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction: for the Orange Park Acres site, the City of Orange; for the Centennial High site, the State of California, Office of the State Architect, for the Newport Center site, the City of Newport, and for the Rosebowl cell site, the City of Pasadena.
- 7. Advice Letter No. 82 states that in addition to the entities listed above, the Federal Communications Commission and the Federal Aviation Administration have jurisdiction over the cell site construction but do not require additional permits for that construction.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP's request for authority to construct the Orange Park Acres, Centennial High, Newport Center, and Rosebowl cell sites is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is November 17, 1990.
