



Resolution T-14221  
Effective November 9, 1990

Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located at 2210 Marine Ave. Ste A, Gardena, California and is known as the Gardena Cell Site #241. It will consist of a 5-foot antenna mounted on an existing building.

The Gardena Cellular Site #241 will become part of LACTC's cellular system serving the Los Angeles Geographic Cellular Geographic Service Area.

Public notice that LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 73 requesting authority to construct the Gardena Cellular Site #241 appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's October 11, 1990 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LACTC's Advice Letter No. 73 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on LACTC's Advice Letter No. 73.

FINDINGS

1. On October 10, 1990, LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 73 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Gardena Cellular Site #241 located at 2210 Marine Ave. Ste A, Gardena, California.
2. The Gardena Cell Site #241 represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.86-06-058, granting LACTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 73 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.



5. An LACTC officer signed a declaration which states that LACTC has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 73.
6. Advice Letter No. 73 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Gardena Cellular Site #241: the County of Los Angeles, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY's request for authority to construct the Gardena Cellular Site #241 is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is November 9, 1990.
