RESOLUTION

American Telephone & Telegraph Company of California. Order authorizing represcription of 1990 straight-line remaining life depreciation rates for all telephone plant.

SUMMARY

American Telephone & Telegraph Company of California (AT&T) proposed represcription of its 1990 depreciation rates for all telephone plant in April 1990. Based on review for reasonableness, the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) of the California Public Utilities Commission reached an agreement with AT&T concerning appropriate depreciation rates. Following notification and a comment period for interested parties, the California Commission authorizes the 1990 straight-line remaining life depreciation rates for all telephone plant for AT&T as set forth in Table A.

BACKGROUND

On July 25, 1990, AT&T filed with the CPUC for represcription of depreciation rates for telephone plant. Represcription of depreciation rates includes review of depreciation rates to reflect changes in service life, future net salvage, and retirement patterns due to technological changes and growth of telephone plant. Previously on February 15, 1989, AT&T filed for represcription with the FCC. The FCC authorized AT&T's request on January 31, 1990 for the calendar year 1990.

AT&T was advised by the DRA staff to remove the impacts of reserve deficiency amortizations and use of equal life group (ELG) method as required in Commission Decision 85-08-047. AT&T amended its request and filed for represcription of the depreciation rates effective January 1, 1990 resulting in an

increase in depreciation accrual of \$3.75 million based on January 1, 1990 plant of \$568 million.

The depreciation rates of AT&T were last represcribed by Resolution T-13095, dated September 7, 1989.

In accordance with the procedures for depreciation reviews adopted by the Commission on September 13, 1977, the Depreciation Group of the Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) gave notice of the proposed depreciation rates to interested parties by letter dated October 3, 1990. No protests or comments during the 30-day response period were received.

PINDINGS

- 1. The depreciation rates set forth in Table A are reasonable.
- 2. No finding is made concerning the reasonableness or unreasonableness of investment for each class of plant.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Authority is granted to make the depreciation rate revisions shown in Table A of this resolution, effective for calendar year 1990.
- 2. The effective date of this resolution is today.
