R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14245. LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF NEW CELLS SITE IN THE LOS ANGELES METROPOLITAN AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 83, FILED ON NOVEMBER 9, 1990.

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SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (LASLP), by Advice Letter No. 83, filed on November 9, 1990, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add new cellular radiotelephone cell sites to its existing cellular system serving the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the new cell sites, known as the Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park sites, located at 1650 South Pacific Coast Highway, Redondo Beach, CA, 8807 West Pico Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA, 13031 San Antonio Street, Norwalk, CA, 1300 West Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles, CA, and 12911 Garvey Avenue, Los Angeles, CA respectively. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 83 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

LASLP has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): the City of Redondo Beach, the City of Los Angeles, the City of Norwalk, City of Baldwin Park,

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the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located at 1650 South Pacific Coast Highway, Redondo Beach, 8807 West Pico Boulevard, Los Angeles, 13031 San Antonio Street, Norwalk, 1300 West Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles and are known as the Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park sites respectively. The Hollywood Riviera site consists of a face mounted antenna attached to an existing building and construction of 729 square foot of equipment shelter in the building. The Mid City Robertson site consists of a antenna attached to the parapet of an existing building and construction of a 1050 square foot equipment shelter in the building. The Norwalk site consists of three antennas on top of an existing building and a 480 square foot equipment shelter in the building. The Downtown site consists of a face mount antenna attached to the parapet of an existing building and construction of a 516 square foot equipment shelter in the building. Finally, the Baldwin Park site consists of a 60 foot monopole antenna and construction of an 8 foot by 35 foot equipment shelter.

The Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park sites will become part of IASLP's cellular system serving the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area.

Public notice that LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 83 requesting authority to construct the Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park sites appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's November 9, 1990 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of IASLP's Advice Letter No. 83 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on IASLP's Advice Letter No. 83.

FINDINGS

1. On November 9, 1990 5, 1990, LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 83 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park cell sites located at 1650 South Pacific Coast Highway, Redondo Beach, 8807 West Pico Boulevard, Los Angeles, 13031 San Antonio Street, Norwalk, 1300 West Olympic Boulevard, Los Angeles, and 12911 Garvey Avenue, Los Angeles respectively.


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2. The Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park sites represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in Decision 87-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 83 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
5. A LASLP officer signed a declaration which states that LASLP has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 83.
6. Advice Letter No. 83 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park cell site: the City of Redondo Beach, the City of Los Angeles, the City of Norwalk, City of Baldwin Park, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP's request for authority to construct the Hollywood Riviera, Mid City Robertson, Norwalk, Downtown, Baldwin Park cell sites is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is December 5, 1990.
