The proposed construction will be located at 212 Shaw Road, South San Francisco and is known as the South San Francisco site. It will consist of one 65-foot steel monopole painted light grey, one prefabricated building housing radio equipment, and a six foot chain-link fence.

The South San Francisco site will become part of GTEM-CA, Ltd.'s cellular system serving GTEM's authorized Cellular Geographic Service Area.

Public notice that GTE Mobilnet of California Limited Partnership filed Advice Letter No. 55 requesting authority to construct the South San Francisco site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's December 4, 1990 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of GTEM-CA, Ltd.'s Advice Letter No. 55 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on GTEM-CA, Ltd.'s Advice Letter No. 55.

FINDINGS

1. On November 30, 1990, GTE Mobilnet of California Limited Partnership filed Advice Letter No. 55 requesting Executive authorization to construct the South San Francisco cell site located at 212 Shaw Road, South San Francisco.
2. The South San Francisco site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.84-11-029, granting GTEM-CA, Ltd. a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 55 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.



5. A GTEM-CA, Ltd. officer signed a declaration which states that GTEM-CA, Ltd. has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 55.
6. Advice Letter No. 55 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the South San Francisco cell site: The City of South San Francisco, the FAA.

- (1) GTE Mobilnet of California Limited Partnership's request for authority to construct the South San Francisco cell site is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is December 20, 1990.
