R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14270. U S WEST CELLULAR OF CALIFORNIA, INC. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A NEW CELL SITE IN THE SAN DIEGO CELLULAR GEOGRAPHIC SERVICE AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 34, FILED ON November 26, 1990.

SUMMARY

U S WEST Cellular of California, Inc. (U S WEST), by Advice Letter No. 34, filed on November 26, 1990, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a new cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving the San Diego Cellular Geographic Service Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the new cell site, known as Cell Site #38, located at 390 Front Street, El Cajon, CA 92020. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 34 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

U S WEST has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California

Public Utilities Commission); the City of El Cajon and the Federal Aviation Administration.

The proposed construction will be located at 390 Front Street, El Cajon, CA 92020 and is known as Cell Site #38. It will consist of a new sixty foot monopole and a 12-foot by 30-foot prefabricated building, located behind an existing building. The tower will support up to five top-mounted omnidirectional antennas, up to twelve panel antennas, and up to two link antennas.

The Cell Site #38 will become part of U S WEST's cellular system serving the San Diego Cellular Geographic Service Area.

Public notice that U S WEST Cellular of California, Inc. filed Advice Letter No. 34 requesting authority to construct the Cell Site #38 site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's November 28, 1990 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of U S WEST's Advice Letter No. 34 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on U S WEST's Advice Letter No. 34.

FINDINGS

1. On November 26, 1990, U S WEST Cellular of California, Inc. filed Advice Letter No. 34 requesting Executive authorization to construct Cell Site #38 located at 390 Front Street, El Cajon, CA 92020.
2. Cell Site #38 represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.85-12-023, granting U S WEST a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 34 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.



4. Advice Letter No. 34 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
5. A U S WEST officer signed a declaration which states that US WEST has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 34.
6. Advice Letter No. 34 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Cell Site #38 cell site: the City of El Cajon and the Federal Aviation Administration.
7. Advice Letter No. 34 states that the City of El Cajon and the Federal Aviation Administration comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Cell Site #38 cell site.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) U S WEST Cellular of California, Inc.'s request for authority to construct Cell Site #38 is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is December 26, 1990.
