R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14271. SACRAMENTO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A NEW CELL SITE IN THE SACRAMENTO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA.

SUMMARY

SACRAMENTO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY (SCTC), by Advice Letter No. 37, filed on November 21, 1990, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a new cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving the Sacramento Metropolitan Statistical Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the new cell site, known as the Taylor Monument site, located at 2625 County Road 22, Sacramento, CA. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 37 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

SCTC has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): the County of Yolo, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located at 2625 County Road 22, Sacramento, CA and is known as the Taylor Monument site. It

will consist of 12 antennas mounted on a 130-foot lattice tower and an equipment shelter

The Taylor Monument site will become part of SCTC's cellular system serving the Sacramento Metropolitan Statistical Area.

Public notice that SACRAMENTO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 37 requesting authority to construct the Taylor Monument site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's November 28, 1990 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of SCTC's Advice Letter No. 37 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on SCTC's Advice Letter No. 37.

FINDINGS


1. On November 21, 1990, SACRAMENTO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 37 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Taylor Monument cell site located at 2625 County Road 22, Sacramento, CA.
2. The Taylor Monument site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.87-10-037, granting SCTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 37 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
5. A SCTC officer signed a declaration which states that SCTC has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 37.
6. Advice Letter No. 37 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Taylor Monument cell site: the County of Yolo, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

- (1) SACRAMENTO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY's request for authority to construct the Taylor Monument cell site is granted.
