RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION T-14289. LOS ANGELES SNSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF NEW CELL SITES IN THE LOS ANGELES METROPOLITAN AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 87, FILED ON DECEMBER 12, 1990.

SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (LASLP), by Advice Letter No. 87, filed on December 12, 1990, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add new cellular radiotelephone cell sites to its existing cellular system serving the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the new cell sites, known as the Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills, sites located at 1704 Manchester, Los Angeles, CA, 12061 Pipeline Street, Chino, CA, and at Bureau of Land Management property in Riverside County respectively. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 87 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The Guam-Kesik, Garringer, and Indio Hills sites represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in D.87-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

LASLP has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): the City of Los Angeles, the

County of San Bernardino, the County of Riverside, the Bureau of Land Management, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located at 1704 Manchester, Los Angeles, CA, 12061 Pipeline Street, Chino, CA, and at Bureau of Land Management property in Riverside County respectively and are known as the Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills sites respectively. The Guam-Kesik site will consist of an antenna attached to an existing building and an equipment shelter in an existing building. The Garringer site consist of a 60-foot monopole antenna and an equipment shelter. The Indio Hills site consist of two antennas and microwave dishes on an existing tower and an equipment shelter.

The Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills sites will become part of LASLP's cellular system serving the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area.

Public notice that LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 87 requesting authority to construct the Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills sites appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's December 12, 1990 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LASLP's Advice Letter No. 87 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on LASLP's Advice Letter No. 87.

PINDINGS

- 1. On December 12, 1990, LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 87 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills cell sites located at 1704 Manchester, Los Angeles, CA, 12061 Pipeline Street, Chino, CA, and at Bureau of Land Management property in Riverside County respectively.
- 2. The Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills sites represent an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.87-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.

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- 4. Advice Letter No. 87 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
- 5. A LASLP officer signed a declaration which states that LASLP has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 87.
- 6. Advice Letter No. 87 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills cell sites: the City of Los Angeles, the County of San Bernardino, the County of Riverside, the Bureau of Land Management, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP's request for authority to construct the Guam-Kesik, Garringer, Indio Hills cell sites is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is January 12, 1991.
