## RESQLUTION

RESOLUTION T-14301. LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A NEW CELL SITE IN LACTO'S AUTHORIZED CELLULAR GEOGRAPHIC SERVICE AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 83, FILED ON JANUARY 11, 1991.

#### SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY (LACTC), by Advice Letter No. 83, filed on January 11, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a new cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving LACTC's authorized cellular geographic service area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the new cell site, known as LACTC Cellular Site No.199, located at 9032 Balboa Blvd., Northridge, CA 91325. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

## **BACKGROUND**

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

#### **DISCUSSION**

Advice Letter No. 83 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The new LACTC Cellular Site No.199 site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.84-06-110, granting LACTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

LACTC has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entity and asserts that this entity alone exercises jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): City of Los Angeles.

The proposed construction will be located at 9032 Balboa Blvd., Northridge, CA 91325 and is known as LACTC Cellular Site No.

199. It will consist of a 60 foot antenna to be used with equipment located in an existing building.

LACTC Cellular Site No.199 will become part of LACTC's cellular system serving LACTC's authorized cellular geographic service area.

Public notice that LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 83 requesting authority to construct LACTC Cellular Site # 199 appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's January 16, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LACTC's Advice Letter No. 83 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

### **PROTESTS**

No protests have been filed on LACTC's Advice Letter No. 83.

### **PINDINGS**

- On January 11, 1991, LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 83 requesting Executive authorization to construct LACTC Cellular Site No.199 located at 9032 Balboa Blvd., Northridge, CA 91325.
- LACTC Cellular Site No.199 represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.84-06-110, granting LACTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 4. Advice Letter No. 83 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
- 5. A LACTC officer signed a declaration which states that LACTC has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 83.
- 6. Advice Letter No. 83 lists the following entity exercising jurisdiction over the proposed construction of LACTC Cellular Site # 199: City of Los Angeles.

- (1) LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY's request for authority to construct LACTC Cellular Site # 199 is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is February 11, 1991.
