RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION T-14306. LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF 4 NEW CELL SITES IN THE LASLP'S AUTHORIZED CELLULAR GEOGRAPHIC SERVICE AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 90, FILED ON JANUARY 28, 1991.

SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (LASLP), by Advice Letter No. 90, filed on January 28, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add four new cellular radiotelephone cell sites to its existing cellular system serving the LASLP's authorized cellular geographic service area. This Resolution authorizes the construction four new cell sites, known as the Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD sites, located at 1990 Bundy Drive, L.A. (Sawtelle), 4605 Lankershim Blvd, No. Hollywood (VDA), 19450 Rinaldi St. Tarzana (Chadwick), 15154 South Stret, Santa Ana (OCWD), respectively. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 90 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The four new sites, Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD, represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in

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D.87-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

LASLP has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): for all sites, FCC; for Sawtelle, VDA, and Chadwick, City of Los Angeles; for OCWD, County of Orange.

The proposed construction for the four new cell sites will be located at 1990 Bundy Drive, L.A. (Sawtelle), 4605 Lankershim Blvd, No. Hollywood (VDA), 19450 Rinaldi St. Tarzana (Chadwick), 15154 South Stret, Santa Ana (OCWD) and are known as the Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD sites respectively. The sites will consist of: Sawtelle, construction of a 500 square foot cellular communications facility on the ninth floor of an existing nine story building and installation of cellular antennas inside the building; VDA, construction of a 370 square foot cellular communications facility on the second floor of an existing two story building and installation of cellular antennas on a penthouse; Chadwick, construction of a 640 square foot cellular communications facility on the second floor of an existing two story building and installation of cellular antennas on the roof; OCWD, Construction of an 8' x 40' free-standing cellular communications building and a 45 foor monopole antenna.

The four new cell sites: Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD, will become part of LASLP's cellular system serving the LASLP's authorized cellular geographic service area.

NOTICE

Public notice that LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 90 requesting authority to construct four new cell sites, Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's January 28, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LASLP's Advice Letter No. 90 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

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PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on LASLP's Advice Letter No. 90.

FINDINGS

- 1. On January 28, 1991, LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 90 requesting Executive authorization to construct four new cell sites, Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD, located at 1990 Bundy Drive, L.A. (Sawtelle), 4605 Lankershim Blvd, No. Hollywood (VDA), 19450 Rinaldi St. Tarzana (Chadwick), 15154 South Stret, Santa Ana (OCWD).
- 2. The Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD sites represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in D.87-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 4. Advice Letter No. 90 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
- 5. A LASLP officer signed a declaration which states that LASLP has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 90.
- 6. Advice Letter No. 90 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD cell sites: for all sites: FCC; for Sawtelle, VDA, and Chadwick, City of Los Angeles; for OCWD, County of Orange.
- 7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 90 have been received.

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THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP's request for authority to construct four new cell sites, Sawtelle, VDA, Chadwick, & OCWD, is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is February 28, 1991.
