RESOLUTION T-14307. RANDOLPH CELLULAR LIMITED PARTNERSHIP dba NORTH COAST CELLULAR. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A NEW CELL SITE IN RURAL SERVICE ARFA 336 (CALIFORNIA #1).

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 2, FILED ON JANUARY 25, 1991.

SUMMARY

RANDOLPH CELLULAR LINITED PARTNERSHIP dba NORTH COAST CELLULAR (NORTH COAST), by Advice Letter No. 2, filed on January 25, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a new cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving Rural Service Area 336 (California 11). This Resolution authorizes the construction of the new cell site, known as the Fickle Hill site, located at 6540 Fickle Hill Road, Humboldt County, CA. No protests to this Advice Letter have been received.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 2 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The new Fickle Hill site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.90-10-011, granting NORTH COAST a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

Resolution Number T-14307 Effective Date February 25, 1991 NORTH COAST/A.L. 2/GLH NORTH COAST has obtained any required permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): Humboldt County, Federal Communications Commission. The proposed construction will be located at 6540 Fickle Hill Road, Humboldt County, CA and is known as the Fickle Hill site. It will consist of a nine foot antenna and an associated 100 square foot, one-story equipment shelter The Fickle Hill site will become part of NORTH COAST's cellular system serving Rural Service Area 336 (California #1). NOTICE Public notice that RANDOLPH CELLULAR LIMITED PARTNERSHIP dba NORTH COAST CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 2 requesting authority to construct the Fickle Hill site appeared in the authority to construct the Fickle HIII site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's January 30, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of NORTH COAST's Advice Letter No. 2 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification. **PROTESTS** No protests have been received to NORTH COAST's Advice Letter No. 2. FINDINGS On January 25, 1991, RANDOLPH CELLULAR LIMITED PARTNERSHIP dba NORTH COAST CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 2 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Fickle Hill cell site located at 6540 Fickle Hill Road, Humboldt County, CA. 2. The Fickle Hill site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.90-10-011, granting NORTH COAST a certificate of public convenience and necessity. 3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity. -2- >

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- 4. Advice Letter No. 2 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
- 5. A NORTH COAST officer signed a declaration which states that NORTH COAST has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 2.
- 6. Advice Letter No. 2 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Fickle Hill cell site: Humboldt County, Federal Communications Commission.
- 7. No protest to Advice Letter No. 2 have been received.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) RANDOLPH CELLULAR LIMITED PARTNERSHIP dba NORTH COAST CELLULAR'S Advice Letter No. 2 is hereby approved.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is February 25, 1991.
