R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14327. SACRAMENTO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A NEW CELL SITE IN THE SACRAMENTO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 43, FILED ON January 15, 1991.

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SUMMARY

Sacramento Cellular Telephone Company (SCTC), by Advice Letter No. 43, filed on January 15, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to modify an existing cellular radiotelephone cell site in its cellular system serving the Sacramento Metropolitan Statistical Area. This Resolution authorizes the modifications to the existing cell site, known as the Auburn site, located 800 feet east of the Lincoln and Ferguson intersection in Auburn, California. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity or modifications to previously authorized sites. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 43 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

SCTC has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the

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proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission); the County of Placer, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located 800 feet east of the Lincoln and Ferguson intersection in Auburn, California and is known as the Auburn site. SCTC proposes to replace an existing whip antenna with three directional antennas and to modify the remaining three whip antennas for directional capability.

The Auburn site is part of SCTC's cellular system serving the Sacramento Metropolitan Statistical Area.

Public notice that Sacramento Cellular Telephone Company filed Advice Letter No. 43 requesting authority to construct the Auburn site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's January 18, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of SCTC's Advice Letter No. 43 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

#### PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on SCTC's Advice Letter No. 43.

#### FINDINGS

1. On January 15, 1991, Sacramento Cellular Telephone Company filed Advice Letter No. 43 requesting Executive authorization to modify the Auburn cell site located 800 feet east of the Lincoln and Ferguson intersection in Auburn, California.
2. The modification to the Auburn site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.87-10-037, granting SCTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity, or modifications to previously authorized sites.
4. Advice Letter No. 43 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.


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5. A SCTC officer signed a declaration which states that SCTC has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 43.
6. Advice Letter No. 43 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed modification to the Auburn cell site: the County of Placer, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.
7. No protests have been filed on SCTC's Advice Letter No. 43.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) Sacramento Cellular Telephone Company's request for authority to modify the Auburn cell site is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is February 15, 1991.
