## RESQLUTION

RESOLUTION T-14378. STOCKTON CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A CELL SITE IN THE STOCKTON METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 36, FILED ON MARCH 20, 1991.

## <u>SUMMARY</u>

#### BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

#### DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 36 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The North Manteca site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.87-11-061, granting SKTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

SKTC has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the Resolution Number T-14378 Effective Date April 22, 1991 SKTC/A.L. No. 36/GLH

proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): Federal Aviation Administration, the Federal Communications Commission, and the County of San Joaquin.

The proposed construction will be located at 12776 So. Castle Rd., Manteca, CA and is known as the North Manteca site. It will consist of a one hundred and eleven foot lattice tower bearing twelve cellular antennas and a microwave dish and a 12' x 28' x 10' concrete and steel modular building housing radio transmitting and receiving equipment.

The North Manteca site will become part of SKTC's cellular system serving the Stockton Metropolitan Statistical Area.

### NOTICE

Public notice that STOCKTON CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 36 requesting authority to construct the North Manteca site appeared in the California Public Utilities <u>Commission's March 22</u>, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of SKTC's Advice Letter No. 36 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

#### PROTESTS

No protests have been received to SKTC's Advice Letter No. 36.

#### FINDINGS

- 1. On March 20, 1991, STOCKTON CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 36 requesting Executive authorization to construct the North Manteca cell site located at 12776 So. Castle Rd., Manteca, CA.
- The North Manteca site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.87-11-061, granting SKTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 3. Décision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requiréments for the filing of advice letters réquésting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephoné facilities not déscribed in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- Advice Letter No. 36 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.

- 7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 36 have been received.
