R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14384. LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF THREE CELL SITES IN THE LOS ANGELES METROPOLITAN AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 93, FILED ON MARCH 6, 1991.

SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (LASLP), by Advice Letter No. 93, filed on March 6, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add three cellular radiotelephone cell sites to its existing cellular system serving the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction three cell sites, known as the Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2 sites, located at 12938 Hoover Street, Los Angeles, 150 North Santa Anita Avenue, Arcadia, and 2200 East LaCadena Drive, Riverside, respectively. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 93 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The three sites, Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2, represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in D.84-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

LASLP has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): the Cities of Los Angeles, Arcadia, and Riverside, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction for the three cell sites will be located at 12938 Hoover Street, Los Angeles, 150 North Santa Anita Avenue, Arcadia, and 2200 East LaCadena Drive, Riverside and are known as the Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2 sites respectively. The Harbor Freeway site consists of placement of antennas on a 60-foot monopole, a 8-foot by 40-foot cellular structure, and an equipment shelter. The Arcadia site consist of placement of antennas on an existing building and a cellular facility on the seventh floor of an existing building. The Riverside Junction 2 site consists of placement of antennas on a 60-foot monopole, a 8-foot by 35-foot cellular structure and an equipment shelter.

The three cell sites, Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2, will become part of LASLP's cellular system serving the Los Angeles Metropolitan Area.

Public notice that LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 93 requesting authority to construct three cell sites, Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2 appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's March 11, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LASLP's Advice Letter No. 93 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

FINDINGS


1. On March 6, 1991, LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 93 requesting Executive authorization to construct three cell sites, Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2, located at 12938 Hoover Street, Los Angeles, 150 North Santa Anita Avenue, Arcadia, and 2200 East LaCadena Drive, Riverside respectively.
2. The Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2 sites represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in D.84-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 93 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
5. A LASLP officer signed a declaration which states that LASLP has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 93.
6. Advice Letter No. 93 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Harbor Freeway, Arcadia, and Riverside Junction 2 cell sites: the Cities of Los Angeles, Arcadia, and Riverside, the Federal Aviation Administration, and the Federal Communications Commission.
7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 93 have been received.
