RESOLUTION T-14385. FRESNO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY.  
EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A CELL SITE  
IN THE FRESNO METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 27, FILED ON MARCH 26, 1991.

SUMMARY

FRESNO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY (FCTC), by Advice Letter No. 27, filed on March 26, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a new cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving the Fresno Metropolitan Statistical Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the cell site, known as the China Peak site, located at Inspiration Point, County of Fresno. No protests to this Advice Letter have been received.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 27 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The China Peak site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.87-10-036, granting FCTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

FCTC has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise

all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission); U.S. Forest Service, and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located at Inspiration Point, County of Fresno and is known as the China Peak site. It will consist of four cellular antennas mounted on an existing 110' lattice tower and radio equipment occupying 4 sq. feet of an existing 10' x 18' equipment shelter.

The China Peak site will become part of FCTC's cellular system serving the Fresno Metropolitan Statistical Area.

#### NOTICE

Public notice that FRESNO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 27 requesting authority to construct the China Peak site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's March 29, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of FCTC's Advice Letter No. 27 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

#### PROTESTS

No protests have been received to FCTC's Advice Letter No. 27.

#### FINDINGS

1. On March 26, 1991, FRESNO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 27 requesting Executive authorization to construct the China Peak cell site located at Inspiration Point, County of Fresno.
2. The China Peak site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.87-10-036, granting FCTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 27 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.



5. An FCTC officer signed a declaration which states that FCTC has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 27.
6. Advice Letter No. 27 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the China Peak cell site: U.S. Forest Service, and the Federal Communications Commission.
7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 27 have been received.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) FRESNO CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY's Advice Letter No. 27 is hereby approved.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is April 26, 1991.
