RESOLUTION T-14427. PACTEL CELLULAR. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF ONE NEW CELL SITE AND MODIFYING AN EXISTING CELL SITE IN THE SAN DIEGO METROPOLITAN AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 60, FILED ON MAY 3, 1991.

SUMMARY

PACTEL CELLULAR (PACTEL), by Advice Letter No. 60, filed on May 3, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add one new cellular radiotelephone cell site and modify another existing site for its cellular system serving the San Diego Metropolitan Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the Point Loma cell site at the southern border of the U.S. Navy's Point Loma Military Reservation, near Humphrey's Road and modification of the Chula Vista Hospital site, located at 751 Medical Center Court, Chula Vista, CA. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 60 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The two sites, Point Loma and Chula Vista Hospital, respectively represent an additional and a modified cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.85-04-023, granting PACTEL a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

PACTEL has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): for Point Loma: Federal Aviation Administration, Federal Communications Commission, California Coastal Commission, U.S. Navy; for Chula Vista Hospital: City of Chula Vista, FCC, State of California -Offices of Statewide Health Planning and Development.

The proposed construction for the Point Loma cell site is located at the southern border of the U.S. Navy's Point Loma Military Reservation, near Humphrey's Road. Modification is proposed for the Chula Vista Hospital site located at 751 Medical Center Court, Chula Vista, CA. The Point Loma site will consist of an 8' x 10' cellular communications facility with sectorized roof-mounted antennas and an adjacent four-foot-diameter microwave dish. Total height of building and antennas will be less than 15'. At the Chula Vista Hospital site, modifications will consist of adding facade mounted cellular panel antennas and removing eight of ten existing whip antennas.

No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

The new and modified cell sites, Point Loma and Chula Vista Hospital, will be parts of PACTEL's cellular system serving the San Diego Metropolitan Area.

NOTICE

Public notice that PACTEL CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 60 requesting authority to construct the Point Loma cell site and modify the Chulá Vista Hospital cell site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's May 10, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of PACTEL's Advice Letter No. 60 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on PACTEL's Advice Letter No. 60.

PINDINGS

1. On May 3, 1991, PACTEL CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 60 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Point Loma cell site at the southern border of the U.S. Navy's Point Loma Military Reservation near Humphrey's Road and to modify the Chula Vista Hospital site located at 751 Medical

> Center Court, Chula Vista, CA. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

- The Point Loma and Chula Vista Hospital sites represent an Ż. additional cellular radiotelephone facility and a modified. cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.85-04-023, granting PACTEL a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting 3. authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- Advice Letter No. 60 conforms to the requirements of 4. Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
- A PACTEL officer signed a declaration which states that 5. PACTEL has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 60.
- 6. Advice Letter No. 60 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Point Loma cell site: FAA, FCC, California Coastal Commission, U.S. Navy; for alteration of the Chula Vista Hospital cell site: City of Chula Vista, Federal Communications Commission, State of California - Offices of Statewide Health Planning and Development.
- 7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 60 have been received.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- PACTEL CELLULAR's request for authority to construct the Point Loma cell site and to modify the Chula Vista Hospital cell site is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is June 3, 1991.
