R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14535. PACTEL CELLULAR. EXECUTIVE ORDER
AUTHORIZING THE MODIFICATION OF THREE EXISTING CELL
SITES IN THE SAN DIEGO METROPOLITAN AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 65, FILED ON JUNE 26, 1991.

SUMMARY

PACTEL CELLULAR (PACTEL), by Advice Letter No. 65, filed on June 26, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to modify three existing cellular radiotelephone cell sites in its existing cellular system serving the San Diego metropolitan area. This Resolution authorizes the modification of the existing cell sites, known as the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada sites, located at 3701 Arroyo Sorrento Road, Black Mountain between Interstate 15 and Black Mountain Rd., and Mt. Ada Road, between Mt. Riäs Place and Mt. Albertine Ave. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction or modification of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to modify after it has received all approvals for the proposed modification required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed modification, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 65 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to modify existing cellular facilities.

The modification of the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada sites represent changed cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in D.85-04-023, granting PACTEL a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

PACTEL has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed modification (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): City of San Diego, Federal Communications Commission, Federal Aviation Administration.

The proposed modification will be to three existing sites known as the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada sites located respectively at 3701 Arroyo Sorrento Road, Black Mountain between Interstate 15 and Black Mountain Rd., and Mt. Ada Road, between Mt. Rias Place and Mt. Albertine Ave. At each site, antennas will be added to existing antenna supports

The modifications to the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada sites will become part of PACTEL's cellular system serving the San Diego metropolitan area.

NOTICE

Public notice that PACTEL CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 65 requesting authority to modify the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada sites appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's June 28, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of PACTEL's Advice Letter No. 65 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on PACTEL's Advice Letter No. 65.

FINDINGS

1. On June 26, 1991, PACTEL CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 65 requesting Executive authorization to modify the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada cell sites located respectively at 3701 Arroyo Sorrento Road, Black Mountain between Interstate 15 and Black Mountain Rd., and Mt. Ada Road, between Mt. Rias Place and Mt. Albertine Ave.
2. The modifications to Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada site represent changed cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in 85-04-023, granting PACTEL a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct or modify cellular



- radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 65 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
 5. A PACTEL officer signed a declaration which states that PACTEL has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 65.
 6. Advice Letter No. 65 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed modification of the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada cell site: City of San Diego, Federal Communications Commission, Federal Aviation Administration.
 7. No protests to Advice Letter 65 have been received.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) PACTEL CELLULAR's request for authority to modify the Sorrento Valley, Black Mountain, and Mt. Ada cell sites is granted.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is July 26, 1991.
