R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14545. LOS ANGELES SMSA LIMITED PARTNERSHIP. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF THREE (3) NEW CELL SITES IN THE LOS ANGELES CELLULAR GEOGRAPHIC SERVICE AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 107, FILED ON July 3, 1991.

SUMMARY

Los Angeles SMSA Limited Partnership (LASLP), by Advice Letter No. 107, filed on July 3, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add three (3) new cellular radiotelephone cell sites to its existing cellular system serving the Los Angeles Cellular Geographic Service Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction three (3) new cell sites, known as Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2, located at 12862 Garden Grove Boulevard, Unit L, Garden Grove, California 92640; 1600 Sawtelle Boulevard, Los Angeles, California 90064; and 519 North Maple Street, Corona, California 91720, respectively. No protests to this Advice Letter have been filed.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 107 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The three (3) new sites, Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2, represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not

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described in Decision 84-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

LASLP has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission); the Federal Aviation Administration, the Federal Communications Commission, the City of Garden Grove, the City of Los Angeles, and the City of Corona.

The proposed construction for the three (3) new cell sites will be located at 12862 Garden Grove Boulevard, Unit L, Garden Grove, California 92640; 1600 Sawtelle Boulevard, Los Angeles, California 90064; and 519 North Maple Street, Corona, California 91720 and are known as the Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2 sites, respectively. Improvements at the respective sites will consist of the following.

The Garden Grove cell site will consist of a 602 square foot cellular communications facility on the first floor of an existing two story building. The facility will consist of interior space to house electrical radio and power equipment. The project also involves the placement of 2 microwave dishes and 3 sets of cellular grid antennas with 4 antennas per grid attached to the roof of the building.

The Buenos Ayres cell site will consist of a 440 square foot cellular communications facility on the second floor of an existing four story building. The facility will consist of interior space to house electrical radio and power equipment. The project also involves the placement of 2 microwave dishes and 3 sets of cellular grid antennas with 4 antennas per grid.

The Corona 2 cell site will consist of a 8 foot by 35 foot free-standing cellular communications structure to house electrical radio and power equipment. The project also involves the placement of 2 microwave dishes and 3 sets of cellular grid antennas with 4 antennas per grid attached to a 90 foot monopole.

The three (3) new cell sites, Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2, will become part of LASLP's cellular system serving the Los Angeles Cellular Geographic Service Area.

NOTICE

Public notice that Los Angeles SMSA Limited Partnership filed Advice Letter No. 107 requesting authority to construct three (3) new cell sites, Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2, appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's July 8, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LASLP's Advice Letter No. 107 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities

either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been filed on LASLP's Advice Letter No. 107.

FINDINGS

1. On July 3, 1991, Los Angeles SMSA Limited Partnership filed Advice Letter No. 107 requesting Executive authorization to construct three (3) new cell sites, Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2, located at 12862 Garden Grove Boulevard, Unit L, Garden Grove, California 92640; 1600 Sawtelle Boulevard, Los Angeles, California 90064; and 519 North Maple Street, Corona, California 91720, respectively.
2. The Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2 sites represent additional cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in Decision 84-04-014, granting LASLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
4. Advice Letter No. 107 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
5. A LASLP officer signed a declaration which states that LASLP has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 107.
6. Advice Letter No. 107 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Garden Grove, Buenos Ayres, and Corona 2 cell sites: the Federal Aviation Administration, the Federal Communications Commission, the City of Garden Grove, the City of Los Angeles, and the City of Corona 2.
7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 107 have been received.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:
