# RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION T-14558. SACRAMENTO VALLEY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A CELL SITE IN THE GREATER SACRAMENTO VALLEY METROPOLITAN AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 59, FILED ON JULY 12, 1991.

### SUMMARY

SACRAMENTO VALLEY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP (SVLP), by Advice Letter No. 59, filed on July 12, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a new cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving the greater Sacramento Valley metropolitan area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the cell site, known as the Bloomer site, located 200 - feet South of Bloomer Hill Lookout, approximately 1 mile East of Ponderosa Way, 7 miles North of Oro Quincy, Oroville. No protests to this Advice Letter have been received.

### BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

## **DISCUSSION**

Advice Letter No. 59 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The Bloomer site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.85-05-041, granting SVLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

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SVLP has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): County of Butte, Federal Aviation Administration, Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located 200' South of Bloomer Hill Lookout, approximately 1 mile East of Ponderosa Way, 7 miles North of Oro Quincy, Oroville and is known as the Bloomer site. It will consist of a 12' x 28' prefabricated shelter contains cellular radiotelephone communications equipment and a 160 foot self-supporting lattice tower.

The Bloomer site will become part of SVLP's cellular system serving the greater Sacramento Valley metropolitan area.

## NOTICE

Public notice that SACRAMENTO VALLEY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 59 requesting authority to construct the Bloomer site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's July 17, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of SVLP's Advice Letter No. 59 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

#### PROTESTS

No protests have been received to SVLP's Advice Letter No. 59.

# **PINDINGS**

- 1. On July 12, 1991, SACRAMENTO VALLEY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP filed Advice Letter No. 59 requesting Executive authorization to construct the Bloomer cell site located 200' South of Bloomer Hill Lookout, approximately 1 mile East of Ponderosa Way, 7 miles North of Oro Quincy, Oroville.
- 2. The Bloomer site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.85-05-041, granting SVLP a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.

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- 4. Advice Letter No. 59 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
- 5. A SVLP officer signed a declaration which states that SVLP has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 59.
- 6. Advice Letter No. 59 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Bloomer cell site: County of Butte, Federal Aviation Administration, Federal Communications Commission.
- 7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 59 have been received.

# THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) SACRAMENTO VALLEY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP's Advice Letter No. 59 is hereby approved.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is August 12, 1991.
