RESOLUTION T-14601. LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY. EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A CELL SITE IN THE LOS ANGELES CELLULAR GEOGRAPHIC STATISTICAL AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 162, FILED ON AUGUST 12, 1991.

SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY (LACTC), by Advice Letter No. 162, filed on AUGUST 12, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving the Los Angeles Cellular Geographic Statistical Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the cell site, known as the site number 320, located at 641 N. Sepulveda, Los Angeles CA. No protests to this Advice Letter have been received.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 162 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The site number 320 represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.84-06-010, granting LACTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity. T-14601 Septmber 12, 1991 LACTC/A.L. No. 162/KBW

LACTC has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): the City of Los Angeles and the Federal Communications Commission.

The proposed construction will be located at 641 N. Sépulvéda, Los Angeles CA and is known as the site number 320. It will consist of 4 antennas rising a maximum of 4 feet above rooftop, attached to an existing two story commercial building in which the communication equipment will be placed.

The site number 320 will become part of LACTC's cellular system serving the Los Angeles Cellular Geographic Statistical Area.

Public notice that LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 162 requesting authority to construct the site number 320 appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's August 16, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of LACTC's Advice Letter No. 162 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been received to LACTC's Advice Letter No. 162.

FINDINGS

- 1. On AUGUST 12, 1991, LOS ANGELES CELLULAR TELEPHONE COMPANY filed Advice Letter No. 162 requesting Executive authorization to construct site number 320 located at 641 N. Sepulveda, Los Angeles CA.
- 2. The site number 320 represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in D.84-06-010, granting LACTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
- 3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.
